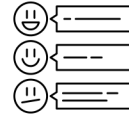
Read online reviews and ask for references from past clients to gauge the contractor's reliability and quality of work.

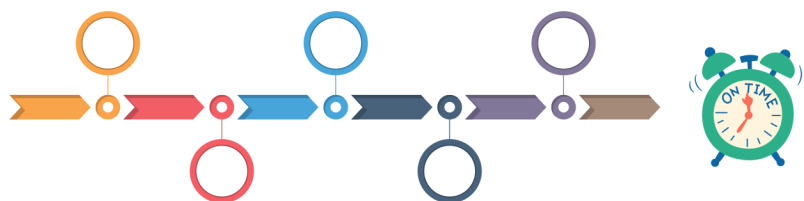
#### 7. Discuss Project Timeline:

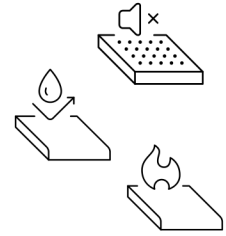
### 8. Choose the Right Drywall Material:
